



First question for tour 2 starts in Esch-sur-Sure. What colourful objects do you find just after the Tunnel if you come from the lake side on the way back from the first break?


How much windows does the square tower of the castle of Esch-sur-Sure have?

Restaurant "Reilander Millen"


Below the painting on the wall you find a hand worked stone that carried in the past a cast plate. How many holes are in it?
